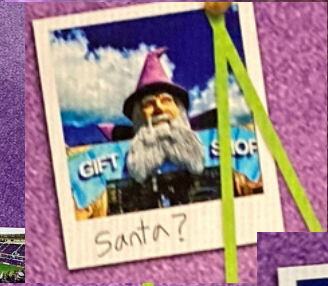
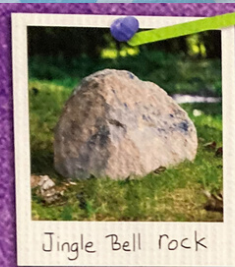
GREETINGS SANTA,

Concept/ Summary:
